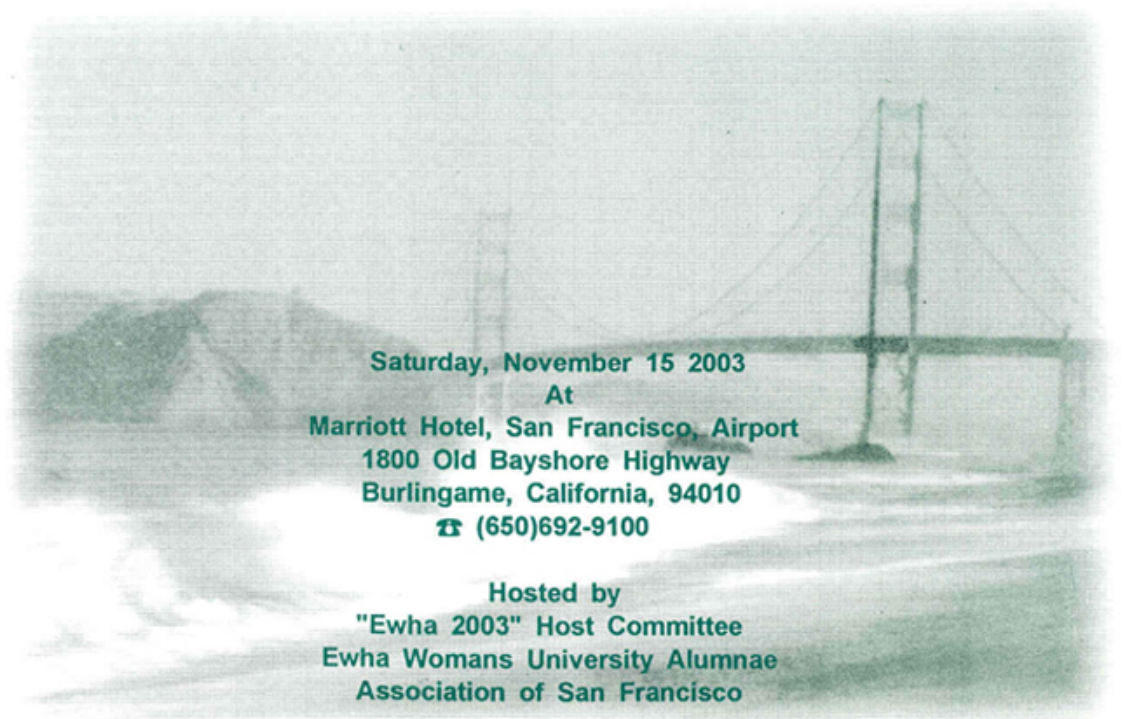

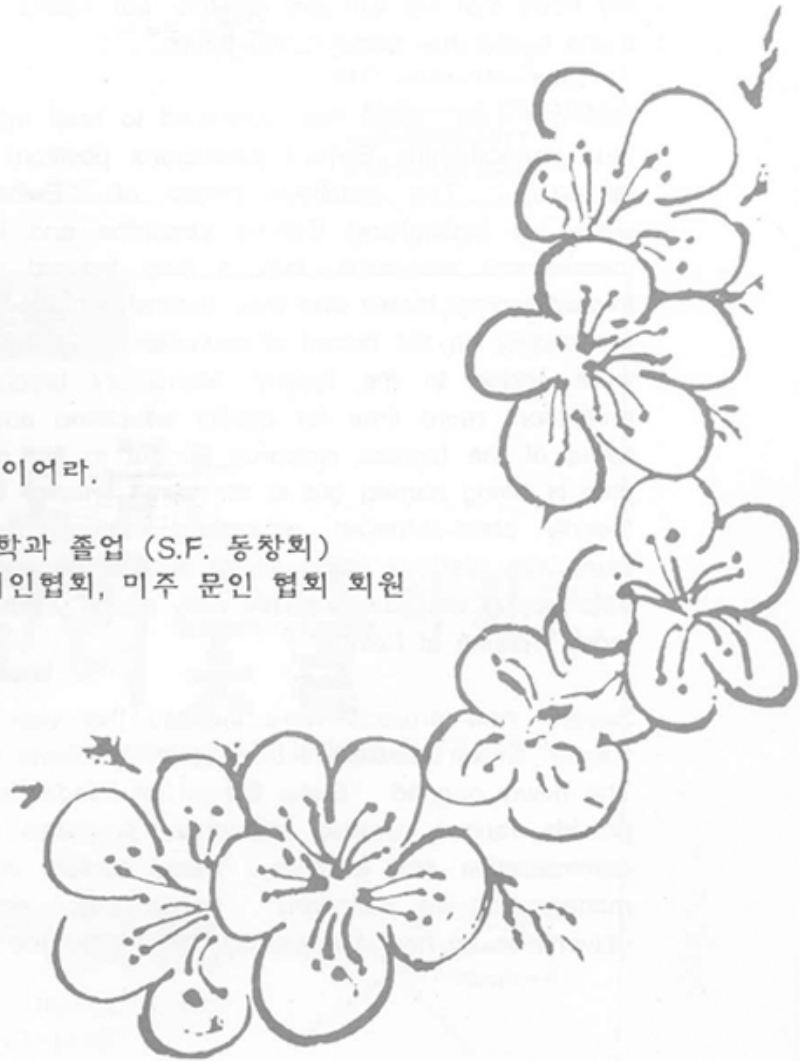

The newly opened "Ewha School for Leadership Development(ESLD)" will seek to provide various detailed educational programs to nurture future leaders of politics, administration and economy. These centers will not only aid in the professional management of Ewhaians' careers, but also provide the standard for other universities on how a university can answer the call of the times and the society.

These accomplishments were only possible because we had the support and participation of the Ewha Alumnae and many friends of Ewha. In fact, it is the love, devotion and efforts of all of you here that have been the stronghold in the development of Ewha.

Dear Ewha alumnae! Every year, Ewha is opening up new horizons in response to the demands of the times. Riding firmly on the wave of globalization, Ewha must now be "Ewha of the World," and not just "Ewha of the Nation." Today Ewha must plan for creative innovations in preparation for the next step in becoming not just the largest but the greatest women's university.

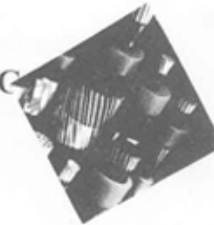

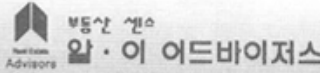

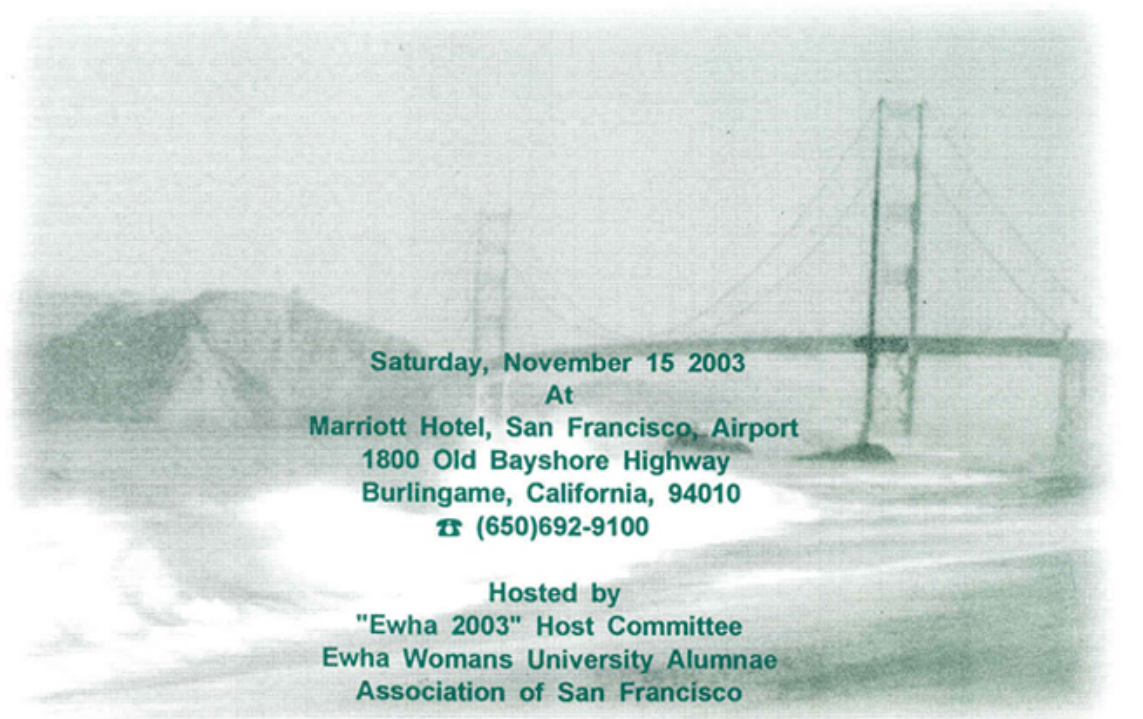
